### **WHMIS 2015 WITH GHS EDUCATION (WITH 2023 AMENDMENTS)**

#### **Description:**

The Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) program is changing in Canada to incorporate the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS).

Workers and Employers need to learn about the changes to product hazard classifications and hazard communication tools, including updated Label requirements and revised Safety Data Sheet formats.
